

TITLES AND ABSTRACTS OF THE PAPERS
FOR COVERING THE PATTERN OF
MA SANSKRIT COURSES OF STUDY UNDER CBCS

In view of the UGC guidelines highlighting the standardization of Indian higher education on par with the international standards and also in view of the framing of uniform the regulations proposed by the Karnataka State Higher Education Council, the courses of study in Sanskrit at the post-Graduate level are to be prepared. Sanskrit studies cover not only the study of the Sanskrit language and literature, but also the study of different schools of knowledge such as systems of Indian philosophy (Daráana), Literary criticism (Sáhitya), Arthaáástra, etc. Thus Sanskrit study being an interdisciplinary in itself, the courses of study have to be planned in such a way as to cover all the disciplines within the subject. Hence it is proposed to cover these under the plan of some compulsory courses and some elective courses so that it suits the CBCS system.

In total Sanskrit courses will be covered under the Four (4) semesters at the rate of two (2) semesters per year. The plan of arranging the courses will be broadly as per the following pattern:

I & II Semesters will have 6 Core Subject papers plus 1 Soft Core paper. Each Core Subject paper will have 4 teaching hours & 4 Credits & the Soft Core paper will have 3 teaching hours & 2 Credits.

III & IV Semesters : will have 2 common papers each & 4 Elective papers each pertaining to three Electives : I Sáhitya, II Daráana and III Arthaáástra. Out of the 4 Elective papers 3 are Core Subject papers and 1 is Open Elective paper. Each Core Subject paper will have 4 teaching hours & 4 Credits & the Open Elective paper will have 4 teaching hours & 3 Credits.
